**MINUTES:**

The Regular School Board Meeting of the School District of Spring Valley was called to order by President Robelia at 6:00 p.m.

School Board members Joan Ford, Sandy Jacobs, April Robelia, Dan Stasiek, Monica Vorlicek, and Jennelle Wolf were present. Also present were John Groh, Nicole Lamb, Chris Segerstrom and 2 others.

There was a motion by Stasiek, seconded by Ford, to approve the agenda as presented. The motion carried.

President Robelia opened the floor for Community Participation. A community member addressed the Board regarding diversity, equity, and inclusion.

There was a motion by Vorlicek, seconded by Wolf, to approve the following Consent Items:

The motion carried.

Principal Lamb presented the Elementary Update on the success of the summer school session, and recognition of Bonnie Tully and Jeremy Donath for their work in organizing class registration, scheduling and transportation.

Principal Segerstrom presented the MS/HS Update about a new Guiding Coalition, which is a group of staff members he is forming to help provide guidance and leadership on where the staff want to take the MS/HS.

There was a motion by Vorlicek, seconded by Stasiek, to approve the monthly and year-end budget report for June 2023. The motion carried.

The Board discussed plans to host a board development workshop in August/September with Durand-Arkansas board president, Bill Yingst and superintendent, Greg Doverspike as guest speakers.

There was a motion by Ford, seconded by Wolf, to approve the 2023-24 superintendent performance goals. The motion carried.

The Board also accepted the resignations of Trisha Forster (Paraprofessional) and Kendra Jones (Paraprofessional).
